Presented by Tito's Handmade Vodka and Stubb's Austin, 100% of ticket sales directly benefit SAFE's programs that support survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault and exploitation, and child abuse in our community. In 2018, SAFE served over 6,000 youth and adults and provided over 106,000 days of care through shelter and residential programs.

This year's SAFE & Sound lineup includes Austin's own Drew Davis and Friends and headliner Jane Ellen Bryant. The event will feature live music, a Tito's ring toss with opportunities for prizes, and opportunities to get involved with SAFE.
